

How to view downloaded videos with captions

*Use these instruction to use English and Spanish
Captions with Downloaded videos.*

1. Download and install [VLC for Windows or Mac](#).
2. Log in to insidemontessori.vhx.tv.
 - a. You will need to redeem your unique code listed on your postcard the first time you visit our video library website.
3. Visit the video page via the Browse tab and select the image to view the INSIDE MONTESSORI video library.
4. Select the video you would like to view.
5. Click the "Subtitle Downloads" dropdown button.
6. Select which language you would like to download, and the SRT will begin downloading to your computer.
7. Click the "Video Downloads" dropdown button.
8. Select which format you would like to download.
9. The video will open in a new screen. Right click the video and select "Download Video As".
10. Place the downloaded video file and subtitle file (SRT) in the same folder on your computer.
11. The video file and subtitle file (SRT) need to have the same name.
 - a. We recommend changing both file names to having INSIDE MONTESSORI in the title.
12. Right click on the video
13. Select "Open With". It's in the drop-down menu. A pop-out menu will appear.
14. Click "VLC Media Player." This is in the pop-out menu. Doing so opens your video in VLC Media Player.
15. Click the "Subtitle" tab. It's at the top of the VLC window. A drop-down menu will appear.
16. Select "Sub track." This is in the drop-down menu. Doing so prompts a new pop-out menu.
17. Click "Track 1." It's in the pop-out menu. You should see your subtitle appear on the video.
