

Tie Dye Socks

You will need:

- At least one pair of socks
- Tie Dye kit with rubberbands
- Clean Water

- 1. Get the socks thoroughly wet, then squeeze out all the excess water until just damp.
 - Fold and rubberband your socks for the desired effect (see sections A-D for further details). Results will vary depending upon how loosely or tightly you twist and rubberband, as well as how much is used.
- 3. Mix the dye according to directions.
- 4. Dye socks in desired colors and patterns.
- 5. Wrap socks in plastic (e.g. baggies, old grocery bags, plastic wrap).
- 6. Let sit for at least 24 hours. The longer they sit, the more vibrant the colors.
- 7. Wash out the dye until the water runs clear.
- 8. Dry the socks in the dryer or lay flat to dry.
- Wear your fancy socks!

SECTION A:

- 1. Fold socks using a fan fold (Pic 1)
- 2. Twist into the shape of a cinnamon roll (Pic 2)
- 3. Rubberband using two bands placed perpendicularly (Pic 3)
- 4. Repeat on the second sock
- 5. Follow steps 3-9 in main directions

SECTION B:



- 1. Fold socks using a fan fold
- 2. Rubberband into even sections (Pic 1)
- 3. Twist the sock (also Pic 1)
- 4. Repeat on the second sock
- 5. Follow steps 3-9 in main directions

SECTION C:







Pic 2



- Pinch and pull the sock up just above the heel line (Pic 1)
- Twist and band that top part, then twist the two remaining halves of the sock together (Pic 2)
- 3. Rubberband the desired remaining sections (Pic 3)
- Repeat on the second sock. 4.
- 5. Follow steps 3-9 in main directions

Dye Example







- Lay the sock flat with the heel on the back side (Pic 1)
- 2. Do a fan fold up the entire sock starting from the bottom (Pic 2)
- 3. Place a rubberband directly around the middle (Pic 3)
- Keep track of the top and outsides of 4. the socks so you can dye it in the desired way (Pic 4)
- Repeat on the second sock. 5.
- 6. Follow steps 3-9 in main directions
