League Play

Our 7U-14U baseball teams will play in a weekday league that will will average between 12-15 league games plus a league playoff. Teams will be placed with the appropriate level of competition.

15U+ baseball will not participate in a league. They will focus on practicing during the week and preparing for tournament play.

Our fastpitch teams will participate in the MMFL league or similar. Teams will be placed with the appropriate level of competition.

Baseball Winter Training

7U Baseball

The 7U Baseball Team will start indoor practices as a team on 1/15/2020 and will practice 1 time per week until the regular season starts. A paid PTA instructor will be at all practices.

8U -18U Baseball

Winter training will feature position/skill specific training led by paid PTA instructors from November 1st to January 15th. We will offer practices sessions that focus primarily on speed & Agility (new for 12U and under this year), hitting, fielding and catching. Players will get access to 2 training sessions per week (total of 18 sessions) for 8U-18U Baseball from November 1st to January 15th, 2020.

Team training will start Janaury 15^{th} , 2020 and go through the start of the season. Teams will have 2 practices per week at our indoor facility. 1 practice will be on a weeknight and the 2^{nd} practice will be on the weekend. During the high school baseball season, we will have a high school open gym in lieu of practices for the 15U-18U teams.

At the middle school (13U/14U) and high school (15U-18U) level, we will continue to incorporate strength and conditioning into our normal practice regime that will be included in the pricing above. We believe that in order to develop our players at the high school level, strength and conditioning has to be key component of winter training. 13/14U players will have up to 30 strength & conditioning sessions included while 15U-18U players will have up to 45 strength & conditioning sessions included in their player fees to utilize from Nov. 1st, 2019 to Mar. 1st, 2020.

Fastpitch Winter Training

Fastpitch winter training will include 1 team practice per week at the indoor facility from November 1st, 2019 until the start of the season. Practices will be led by head coaches with the support of paid PTA Instructors. Fastpitch specific strength & conditioning is available at an additional cost.



Tournament Play

7U teams will play 1-2 tournaments depending on availability.

8U-14U teams will play between 5-10 tournaments depending on their age level and team level (Cardinal, White or Gray – see pricing grid above). Every team that is 12U and under will have a minimum of 1 destination tournament. For example, a tournament in Mauston, Indiana or Omaha. That said, teams are not limited to one travel tournament and may play in multiple travel tournaments depending on the age and level of the team.

We believe that Cooperstown is an awesome experience for our kids. We plan to send our 12U teams there annually. That said, there is a fundraising commitment in addition to the fees outlined in the attached pricing grid.

The 15U-18U teams will play between 5-8 tournaments depending on their age level and team level (Cardinal, White or Gray). We will put our teams in the appropriate exposure tournaments, many of which include travel to Ohio, Indiana, Iowa and Georgia to ensure we are showcasing the talents of our high school players.

The 10U-18U fastpitch teams will play in 5-6 touraments. We will put our teams in the appropriate tournaments including exposure tournaments for our 16U and 18U teams.

Coaches

We will have experienced paid coaches handling winter training for all teams. The teams coaches will be encouraged to participate at practice as they are able to do so.

Team coaches will be required to participate in team practices starting after January 15th.

Cardinal teams will have paid non-parent coaches. Our White and Gray teams will have parent coaches that have been selected by PTA and trained by PTA. Our paid coaches will provide assistance and oversight when available and when requested across all teams.

We will provide skill training at the Rock Sports Complex for all of our athletes from early September to mid October included with the packages listed above.

There will be opportunities for our players to participate in fall ball leagues and tournaments for an additional cost.

For our youth program, there will an opportunity for players to participate in a fall ball league and 1-2 additional tournaments at an additional cost.

For our high school program, there will be an opportunity for our players to participate in a fall ball league and/or 2-3 tournaments, including sending a team to top exposure tournaments this fall at an additional cost.

Facilities, Equipment & Communication Tools

The Rock Sports Complex

The Rock is the exclusive home to Prospect Training Academy and one of the most significant differentiators amongst our competition. The Rock's elite baseball facilities include 4 full-size fields and 2 youth-sized fields and all major league replica fields, which are surfaced with synthetic turf infield and 3-D Ultra Sod and root mix, which is the same product used by the majority of MLB stadiums across the nation. This high-tech playing surface has been designed to accurately mimic the bounce of the ball off of real dirt and grass, and will allow fields to be playable immediately after rain. The complex has 4 outdoor batting cages and each field is equipped with 2 bullpens. Other state-of-the-art features include fully digital scoreboards and field lighting by sports lighting industry leader Qualite.

All NEW PTA Indoor Training Center (Coming 2020)

Our goal is to have the all-new PTA Training Center built as soon as possible. We know this is behind schedule and we had hoped to have this available for this fall. This is behind schedule for a number of reasons outside our control. That said, the process is underway and we look forward to getting into this facility in 2020. In the interim, we will continue to train indoors at the indoor Academy located at 6758 S. 13th St. in Oak Creek.

As for the new PTA Indoor Training Center, our design is contemplated to be one of the leading indoor sports training centers in the region. We will be building a unique indoor training space that will include a full size turf infield, numerous hitting cages, a performance center, classroom, video analysis and scouting office, parent lounge, and retail store.

HitTrax

Patent-pending technology delivers innovation to the baseball industry by measuring real-time data and displaying live results for immediate feedback. Players, instructors, coaches and parents can analyze key performance metrics to identify tendencies before stepping onto the field.

FungoMan produces and sells the most efficient, portable, and advanced baseball practice repetition machines available. For more than 14 years, engineers and programmers at FungoMan® have researched and developed the hardware and software needed to revolutionize practice made perfect. FungoMan will be used during our fall programming and winter training.



Payment Due Dates

We have several options for payments. We utilize SMART Tuition to manage all payment plans. Here are important dates and details for our payment plans:

First Payment: \$300 non refundable deposit due within 24 hours of player offer

Second Payment: Balance is due in full on October 1st, 2019. Payment can be made via credit card or ACH. If you utilize a credit card, there is a service fee to cover the cost of the merchant services fees associated with accepting a credit card. If the payment is made via ACH, there are no additional fees.

Payment Plan: We do offer the ability to set up a payment plan with the balance due in 6 equal payments on the 1st of the month from October, 1st 2019 to March, 1st 2020.

There is a one time \$50 charge to set up the payment plan and if you utilize a credit card, there is a service fee to cover the cost of the merchant services fees associated with accepting a credit card. If payment is made via ACH, there are no additional processing fees.

Expectations

Players Expectations

- Players are expected to put in the work
- Players must be in PTA uniform for training and games.
- Show up on time and ready to practice or play.
- Players are required to hustle on and off the field.
- Fighting between teammates or opponents will not be tolerated.
- No eating during the game or in the dugout.
- Be respectful to EVERYONE –including coaches, umpires, parents, teammates, and visiting team.
- For high school players, update availability via Team Snap.

Parent Expectations

- For youth players, update your child's availability via Team Snap.
- No coaching through the fence or on the sidelines.
- Support the PTA Way
- Do not approach the coach before a game, during a game, or directly after the game.
- Be respectful to EVERYONE including coaches, umpires, parents, players, and visiting team
- Respect the park rules in regards to: no alcohol, no carry-ins, no arguing with umpires, and gate fees.
