

THE 3 BEST WAYS TO REMOVE WAX FROM YOUR WARMER, EASILY AND SAFELY

A guide by Unwicked Scents

No matter how long your Unwicked Scents smelt wax melt lasts, you will need to change the wax. This has been a messy and sometimes dangerous process, but we will share with you the **best methods** we have found for removing used wax from your warmer without creating a mess, burning your fingers or possibly causing a more severe injury such as cutting yourself. We advise that you never handle a hot warmer, and never use a utensil (spoon or knife) to remove wax from your warmer. Doing this could result in ruining your warmer, burning yourself or WORSE cutting yourself.

METHOD 1: THE FREEZER

Once you have allowed your warmer to cool, and allowed the wax to become solid, simply place the warmer dish in the freezer for 5 – 15 minutes. You will know that the wax is ready to be removed when a small gap forms between the wax and the dish. When this happens, take your warmer dish from the freezer and using a paper towel push down on one edge of the wax to pop it from the dish. This should occur without much pressure. If you have to push hard, place the dish back in the freezer for a few more minutes. Discard the wax in the trash.

It is important that the warmer is cooled to room temperature for two reasons: 1. Placing a hot warmer into the freezer can result in stress cracks in the warmer or cause it to shatter. 2. Moving a warmer with melted wax can spill creating a mess or possibly causing a burn. Always allow your warmer dish to return to room temperature prior to using it again.

METHOD 2: ICE

Again, with this method you want to allow your warmer to cool and allow the wax to become solid.

Now, remove the dish from the warmer and place several ice cubes on the surface of the wax. The wax is ready to be removed when a small gap forms between the wax and the dish. When this happens, use a paper towel to push down on one edge of the wax to pop it from the dish.

This should occur without much pressure. If you have to push hard, wait a few more minutes to allow the ice to cool and shrink the wax enough that it can easily be removed. Discard the ice into the sink (do not use this ice for anything else), and discard the wax in the trash.

METHOD 3: SILICONE LINER

This is our favorite method as it doesn't involve freezing the warmer dish, and has very little cleanup.

Simply place a silicone cupcake liner inside your warmer dish and place your Unwicked Scents wax melt inside the cupcake liner for use. Once you are finished, turn off your warmer and allow the wax to become solid. You can now pop the wax directly out of the cupcake liner and into the trash.

These cupcake liners can be purchased at most major retailers or provided to Good Scents Club members and will save you time and effort when cleaning your warmer.

Be sure to never use your silicone cupcake liner for making cupcakes (or any other food contact) after you have used it to hold fragranced candle wax.

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
